Subject: Implementation of Single Nodal Agency (SNA) Model in respect of State Schemes – Furnishing of latest status thereof.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the decisions taken by the Task Force Committee regarding implementation of the Single Nodal Agency (SNA) Model in the State and the subsequent letters issued by this Department from time to time, whereby your Department was selected for implementation of the SNA Model on pilot basis/in a phased manner. The concerned Departments were requested to initiate necessary action for onboarding/migration to the designated participating bank and to undertake all other requisite measures for operationalization of the SNA framework.

2. The implementation of the SNA Model is aimed at strengthening financial management of State Schemes by ensuring streamlined fund flow, effective monitoring of scheme funds and integration with the Public Financial Management System (PFMS). The progress achieved by the Departments in implementation of the SNA framework is required to be reviewed so that the present status may be placed before the competent authority/Task Force Committee for further consideration.

3. In this regard, you are requested to furnish the latest status with regard to implementation of the SNA Model in your Department, indicating, inter alia, the present position regarding opening and operationalization of the designated SNA Bank Account, migration/rationalization of existing bank accounts, integration with PFMS, commencement of fund flow through the SNA framework and any other action taken in pursuance of the decisions of the Task Force Committee.

4. It is also requested that, in case the implementation of the SNA Model has not yet been completed, the reasons for the delay, issues requiring resolution, if any, and the likely timeline for completion of the remaining activities may also be indicated so that the matter can be examined appropriately and necessary support, wherever required, may be extended.

5. The requisite information may kindly be furnished to this Department **within 15 days** positively, enabling this Department to compile the updated status of all the concerned Departments for placing the same before the competent authority.
