- i. To constitute the Working Group with other related major departments, as its members.
- ii. To prepare a vision document keeping in view the Goals set and/or proposed and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for about 15 years for the period up to 2030 this is co-terminus with the period to achieve SDGs.
- iii. To prepare a 7-year strategy from 2017-18 to 2023-24 to convert the longer vision into Implementable policy.
- iv. To prepare a 3-year Action document for 2017-18 to 2019-20 aligned to the predictability of financial resources during the 14th Finance Commission Award period.
