HP State Innovation Award Scheme for recognizing best innovations

HP State Innovation Award Scheme was started in 2014-15 to recognize and encourage local & creative talent by providing financial incentives for the best innovation practices being adopted by them at various sector levels. The Scheme recognizes the efforts of individuals/institutes in the seven identified sectors (initially six), each with a specific Nodal Department for scrutinizing & recommending one best sectoral proposal for award through concerned sectoral committee to be constituted by the Administrative Secretary of Nodal Department under his/her chairmanship.

In the latest meeting of State Innovation Council held in May, 2018, it was also decided to widen the scope of Tourism sector by including non-freight transport sector into the Tourism sector and to include one more sector viz.
